

Fabella Housing Project Inaugurated

THE National Housing Authority (NHA) represented by Ms. Rosalinda R. Nartates and the City Government of Mandaluyong led by Mayor Carmelita “Menchie” Abalos heralded the inauguration and blessing ceremony of The Fabella Housing Project on July 19, 2017.

Located in Fabella New Road, Brgy., Addition HillsMandaluyong City, the low-rise building is a joint undertaking between the Local Government Unit of Mandaluyong and the NHA. The project is under a usufruct agreement as part of the P50 billion resettlement fund for relocating Informal Settler Families (ISFs) living in high-risk areas such as railroad tracks, esteros, and other waterways in Metro Manila.

Towering five stories high, the low-rise building has 68 housing units allotted for family-beneficiaries living along the danger areas of Maytunas Creek and San Juan River.

This is the third in-city housing project in Mandaluyong. The first two were the Busilak, Guminhawa, Kayumanggi (BGK) Project and Aglipay Housing Project, respectively.
