

## **Rebuilding Lives, Rebuilding Communities**

THE National Housing Authority (NHA), in partnership with the Children International Philippines (CI-P) through the “Adopt a Community Program” recently facilitated a drive to donate relief goods to the displaced families in warstricken Marawi. With the help of NHA Cagayan de Oro Project Office, they were able to distribute packs of t-shirt, food items like noodles and rice, and hygiene kits containing toothpaste and hand soap from Clean the World Organization. These relief goods were distributed to the evacuees in Batangan, Saguiran, Lanao del Sur.

Furthermore, the Authority also donated t-shirts, manna packs, hygiene kits, livelihood materials, books, school supplies, and Math and Science Kits for NHA community schools. In August of this year, the Community Relations and Information Operations Department (CRIOD), in partnership with CI Philippines, will conduct a Give a Book Project to the children of Masbate Project beneficiaries. The CRIOD believes that through these small acts of kindness, the Authority can give hope and help rebuild the lives of NHA beneficiaries and survivors of different calamities.
